EYFS Summer Holiday activity ideas

Task 1

Think of something that makes you happy. It might be a person, animal, season or game.

Draw it and ask for an adult to write why this "thing" is special to you. You might want to challenge yourselves to using your phonics and independently writing the reason why it is special.



Go on a scavenger hunt: Can you find



the following things and make a collection: something shiny, something yellow,

something alive, 3 different colours in nature, petal, tiny snail shell, a smooth stone, something spikey, draw a picture of a bird that you can see.

Task 3

Have a teddy bears picnic in the garden. Can you write a list of equipment/food you will need. What

entertainment will you have? You might want to read your toys a story or perform them a song. Make sure you make invitations so everyone knows where and when your picnic isl

Task 6

Make a grid using sticks (eg 3x3).

Can you fill the grid by representing different numbers?

You could use pebbles, feathers, stones, leaves-whatever you can find.

Task 5

Potions and Pies-Collect a range of smelly petals, herbs and other leaves and put



them in an old yoghurt pot. Add warm water, mix and smell it! How much does your perfume cost? Write the ingredients and instructions of how to make it.
